PRIME (SNI Link page and DHCS PRIMEone*)

- **DY15 Manual.** DHCS released the DY15 PRIME Manual on July 10. To access, log in to <u>SNI Link</u>, click on the download link to the Manual or PQA value set, and click "Agree" on the pop up Agreement Form. Email <u>dpong@caph.org</u> if you need help setting up a <u>SNI Link</u> login.
