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I. **Policy and Reporting Updates**

- **Behavioral Health Integration Incentive Program Applications Due January 21.** Medi-Cal providers are encouraged to apply for the DHCS Behavioral Health Integration Incentive Program (BHIIP). In order to apply, providers must complete and sign the application and submit it directly to their Medi-Cal managed care plan no later than 5PM PST on January 21, 2020. CAPH members should be advised that some of the metrics also exist in PRIME, QIP or WPC (see attached email and [crosswalk](#)). To avoid duplicative payment, which is a concern raised by DHCS, in your application, do not define milestones to earn funding related to reporting or performance achievement on metrics you also report for PRIME, QIP, or WPC.
