COVID-19 Update



CAPH Proposed Request to DHCS: PRIME

The extension of reporting deadlines in 2020 (i.e. PRIME 3/31 Mid-Year Report) is needed to account for staff being unable to attend work in person or being diverted to other emergency response activities. Delayed reporting should not incur penalties.

*Approval to **convert performance-based programs 1115 waiver programs to pay-for-reporting**, accounting for the fact that many primary-care and preventive services are being delayed to ensure low-risk patients do not unnecessarily enter hospitals during this emergency response period, and because many staff who were working on items such as prevention calls have been reassigned to emergency response activities.*

Pay-for-reporting is needed in particular for PRIME and Whole Person Care.

CAPH Proposed Request to DHCS: QIP

QIP performance will be impacted by the expected reduction in non-emergency service use and staff activities being redirected to emergency response, or fewer staff being available overall as surges occur and an increased share of the population is exposed to the coronavirus.

We request that metrics be modified to pay-for-reporting for the reporting periods impacted by this emergency (PY 3 and PY 3.5).

We also request reporting extensions, for the same reasons stated in other sections of this request.

DY15 Targets for Certain Metrics

DHCS liaisons will manually enter DY 15 target rates (at MY and YE) for:

- 1.2.5.b – Controlling Blood Pressure
(1.2.10 – Controlling Blood Pressure)
- 1.5.1.b – Controlling Blood Pressure
- 2.5.2 – Controlling Blood Pressure
- 1.6.2 – Breast Cancer Screening
- 1.3.2 – All Cause Readmissions
- 2.2.1 – All Cause Readmissions

2.1.6 Postpartum: Report twice on Mar 31

- 1) In the 2.1.6 numerator and denominator fields of the PRIME DY15 Mid Year Portal, use the **HEDIS 2019** spec in the “PRIME DY15 Reporting Manual” to report and determine an Achievement Value in PRIME DY15. The AV will be automated in the platform.
- 1) In the 2.1.6 narrative field for data capture methodology of the PRIME DY15 Mid Year Portal, use the **HEDIS 2020** spec in the “QIP PY3.5 PRIME Transition Metrics Reporting Manual Project 2.1” to report on this metric. This will establish your PY 3.5 baseline and allow DHCS to develop 2.1.6 benchmarks for PY 3.5.

Use the following dates for baseline and performance, respectively:

- PY3.5 Baseline: Birth dates between Oct 8, 2018-Oct 7, 2019
- PY3.5 Performance: Birth dates between Oct 8, 2019-Oct 7, 2020
