I. POLICY AND REPORTING UPDATES

PRIME/ QIP COVID-19 Impact

- As part of the DHCS emergency 1115 waiver request to CMS on April 3, DHCS requested that for both PRIME DY15 and QIP PY3, P4P apply only to "mid-year" performance (i.e., performance as of December 31, 2019), and that Year End performance (i.e., performance as of June 31, 2020) be changed to P4R. For the P4P period, DHCS, DHLF, and SNI are discussing possible "flexibility with setting targets" starting with DHCS' proposal of 5% gap closure. In order to fully understand the financial impact of this proposal (and variations), David Lown sent a data request to PRIME QIP Leads for PRIME and QIP performances of 12/31/2019 (DY15 MY and an effective PY3 MY). Thank you for your time to share that data last week.
- DHCS has begun discussions with CMS about a 1 year extension to all programs under the 1115 Waiver, which if implemented would delay transition of PRIME metrics into QIP until 2021 (impacting PRIME metrics under QIP PY3.5 as well). CAPH has also received confirmation from Leader Pelosi's office that the Waiver extension request will also be part of the 4th stimulus bill, which will likely be finalized later this fall. Either way, we do not expect a decision on Waiver extension for several months. We will keep everyone informed of the status of this request and all implications, but for now through the end of 2020, there are no changes (aside from the P4R/P4P mentioned above) to the specific metrics being reported on by DPHs.

- **PY4-8 Measure Survey postponed**. See attached email from DHCS. The member survey discussion on May 11 (12-1:30) will be cancelled. Please note, at this time, the survey has not been <u>cancelled</u>, just <u>postponed</u>. SNI, DHLF and DHCS will continue to reassess the ability to restart the survey over the next several months, based on our knowledge of the re-allocation of your analyst and clinical staff away from routine duties and onto COVID-related activities. So once you start shifting your folks back to routine activities, please let us know.
