I. POLICY AND REPORTING UPDATES

PRIME/ QIP COVID-19 Impact

Programmatic updates. Listen to the June 9 webinar "COVID-19 Impact on PHS Programs" (posted here) and to the June 22 PRIME QIP Leads webinar (posted on PRIME and QIP pages). DHCS is waiting for CMS response on the PRIME DY15 and QIP PY3-proposals and is preparing to submit a proposal for PY3.5 using the same approach used for PY3: Use performances as of 2/29/20 with targets equal to the minimum or 25th percentile threshold for all PY3.5 metrics. DHCS is unsure if CMS would be favorable to this PY3.5 proposal as February is outside the official July – Dec 2020 PY3.5 program period.

- DY14 Supplemental Claiming.
 - DHCS June 29 email to PRIME listserv: "In light of COVID-19, DHCS is pursuing enhanced federal funding for the DY 14 Year-End supplemental payments. This enhanced funding is made available through Section 6008 of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act (FFCRA), which provides a temporary 6.2 percentage point increase in the Federal Share. To ensure the payments include the increased federal share, the IGT letters for the DY 14 supplemental payments are now estimated to be sent to entities by the end of July 2020, More details will be shared as they are available. If you have any questions, please feel free to reach out to your PRIME liaison."
 - CAPH Finance is providing updates to CFOs on this. Connect with your CFO for further details.
- DY15 MY report. DHCS is currently conducting the clinical, comprehensive review.
- DY15 YE report. DHCS will be requiring all the usual data by Sept 30 for informational purposes, but is
 considering reducing the amount of quality improvement narratives at the metric-level. DHCS clarification
 forthcoming.
- The PRIME program officially ended June 30. Congratulations for completing 5 years of performance improvement under PRIME! "PRIME" metrics continue under QIP PY3.5 (as "PRIME Transition metrics") which officially started July 1, 2020.
