### PROGRAM UPDATES

#### **Future of GPP**

- 6 month GPP extension (July December 2020) approved
  - CAPH working to add SNCP for the 6-month period
- Extension of GPP as part of waiver extension through December 2021 potential paths for approval:
  - Statutory extension of entire 1115 waiver in House language for next stimulus bill
  - DHCS negotiations with CMS
  - Likelihood of SNCP reinstatement in 2021 is uncertain

#### **PY4 Encounter Data Validation**

CAPH is assessing PY<sub>4</sub>
GPP encounter data for:

- Concordance with aggregate data
- Data completeness

CAPH will reach out if we find major issues.


### **PY5 Interim - Summary**

- County public health care systems (PHS) earned 4% fewer points than PY4 interim
- However, PHS met between 71% and 135% of their target thresholds -- 100% collectively
- Enhanced COVID FMAP effectively lowered GPP thresholds and working with DHCS to implement further threshold reductions
- Inpatient services increased for both BH and physical health
- NT services increased to ~11% of total points earned

# GPP Service Mix To Date PY1-5, Physical Health










### PY5 Interim Physical Health Outpatient Service Trend




# PY5 Interim Physical Health Med/Surg Service Trend






### PY<sub>5</sub> Interim Physical Health Emergency Service Trend



## GPP Service Mix To Date PY1-5, Behavioral Health






Most systems saw decreases in outpatient BH services and increases in BH IP Over half decreased their BH emergency services




## PY5 Interim Behavioral Health Outpatient Service Trend




## PY<sub>5</sub> Interim Behavioral Health Inpatient Service Trend

### **Inpatient Drivers**

#### What is driving inpatient trends?

- Both ICU and Med/Surg increased from PY<sub>4</sub> even with depressed COVID utilization
  - ICU increased 64% from PY4 final
  - Med/Surg increased 13% from PY4 interim
