PY4 Updates

PY₄ Programmatic Updates

- Ongoing: PY₄ negotiations with DHCS & CMS
- Pending: CMS approval of original PY₄ pre-print
- Pending: Details from DHCS on Audit
- Pending: Updated PY₄ Benchmarks from DHCS. **Estimated release: by 10/29**
- Oct 1: "PY₄ R/E Stratification & Q-IHE" webinar slides/recording posted on [eQIP](#).
- Minimum "denominator" cases for Risk Adjusted Measures:
 - Q-PCR: 150 Index Hospital Stays (IHS)
- Save the Date: Jan 25-26, 2022: DHCS Annual QIP Virtual Conference.

PY4 Programmatic Updates

- Oct 4: “PY4 Value Sets for MCP & entity data sharing” posted on QIP [webpage](#).
 - FYI: although there is continuous assignment & allowable gap info listed for Q-CMS147 (Flu) & Q-CMS138 (Tobacco), this is only to guide the Plans on what data to provide entities. It is not to be used to program the measures, as these measures are not based on assigned lives.
 - The language for these measures in the value set doc will be revised in the future to be clearer (for the Plans) and less confusing (for entities).

Currently, only 53% of all possible data have been received so far. Of the collected data:

- 71% of measure rates have data from July-Sep.
- 67% of measure rates are $\geq 25^{\text{th}}$ percentile. 81% are $\geq 10^{\text{th}}$
- Only 42% met original PY4 target
- Many performance rates still based on PY3.5 spec.
- There are few appreciable trends in the data to suggest that certain metrics are more likely to hit targets than others.

PY5 Updates

PY5 Update: Assigned Lives & Non-Entity Data

Measures keeping assigned lives in the target population:

- Q-HLV: HIV Viral Load Suppression
- Q-CMS130: Colorectal Cancer Screening

Measures removing assigned lives from the target population:

- Q-CMS69: BMI Screening/Follow-up
- Q-CMS2: Depression Screening/Follow-up

Non-Entity data allowed for use in determining Negative Histories:

- Q-AAB, Q-URI:
 - Negative Medication History; Negative Comorbid Condition History
- Q-LBP:
 - Negative Diagnosis History

Non-Entity data allowed for use in determining numerator only:

- Q-PCE: COPD Exacerbations
