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CalAIM-Related Funding Initiatives

Incentive Payment Program (IPP)

PATH: Providing Access and Transforming Health

Housing and Homelessness Incentive Program

BH QIP: Behavioral Health Quality Incentive Program

CalAIM-Related Funding Initiatives

- Initiatives are intended to be non-duplicative.
- Targeted to different stakeholders to help develop capacity and reward progress toward CalAIM goals.

CalAIM Incentive Payment Program (IPP)

- **Targeted toward:** Managed Care Plans (MCPs)
- **Funding eligibility:** MCPs can earn incentives for meeting milestones in (1) delivery system infrastructure; (2) ECM provider capacity; (3) community supports provider capacity and take-up; and (4) quality
 - MCP Gap-Filling Plans due to DHCS on December 22, 2021
 - Payment 1 tied to reporting, subject to recoupment
 - Payment 2 tied to metric targets
- **WPC Impact:**
 - Potential to earn IPP for ECM and Community Supports
 - *"DHCS anticipates participating MCPs will maximize the investment and flow of incentive funding to ECM and Community Supports (ILOS) providers to support capacity and infrastructure." (IPP FAQ, page 5)*
 - Consider submitting a proposal to your MCPs for IPP funds ASAP

Providing Access and Transforming Health (PATH)

- **Targeted toward:** Providers (MCPs are NOT eligible to receive PATH), including WPC LEs.
- **Funding eligibility:** Payments to providers to maintain and build capacity for ECM and Community Supports
- **4 PATH Programs:**
 1. WPC Services and Transition to Managed Care Mitigation
 - Funds for WPC services that will continue under ECM or Community Supports, based on approved WPC PY6 FFS/PMPM rates
 - DHCS will work with LEs that use incentive payments to cover WPC services, to ensure these services can be billed as FFS/PMPM
 2. Technical Assistance
 3. Collaborative Planning and Implementation
 4. Capacity and Infrastructure Transition, Expansion, and Development
- **WPC Impact:** Immediate focus on using PATH funds to sustain WPC services that map to ECM and/or Community Supports, until they are offered by the MCP (e.g., MCP takes-up additional Community Supports, serves additional ECM populations of focus)

Housing and Homelessness Incentive Program

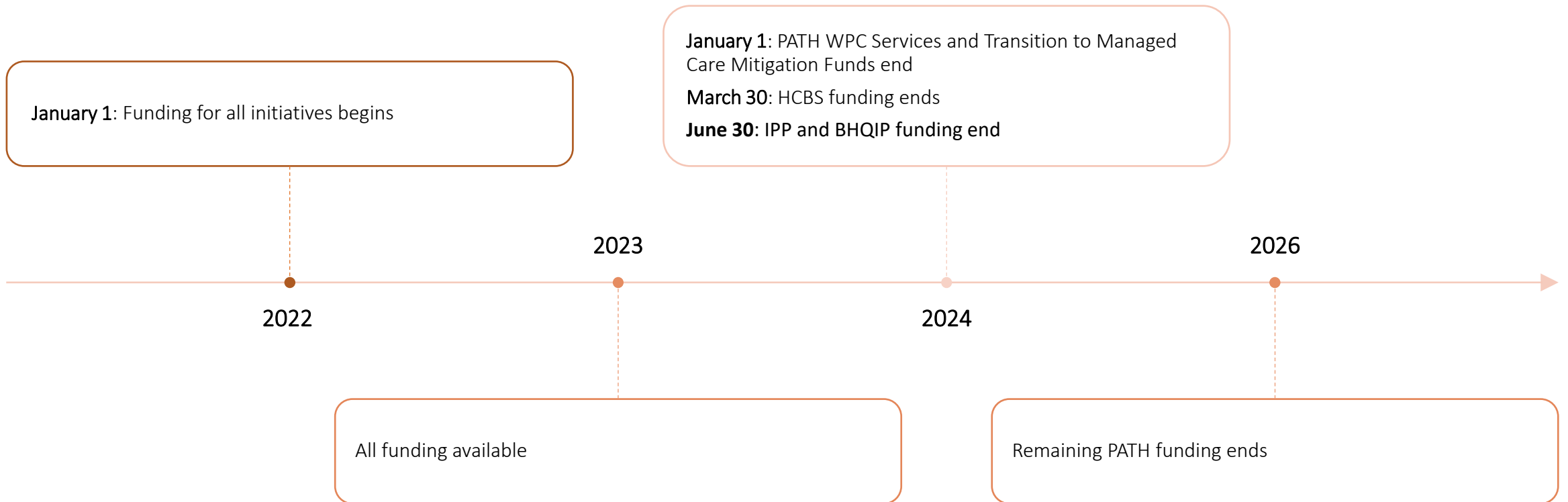
- **Targeted toward:** MCPs, with a requirement that 85% of funds are passed on to beneficiaries, providers, local homeless Continuums of Care, and/or counties
- **Funding eligibility:** Under the Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) spending plan, MCPs can earn incentives for addressing homelessness
- **Examples of eligible activities:**
 - Investment in interim housing for the aging and/or disabled population
 - Investment in rapid rehousing for families and youth
- **WPC impact:** Potential funding to augment to services that will not, or will only partially continue under ECM and Community Supports

BH QIP: Behavioral Health Quality Incentive Program

- **Targeted toward:** County behavioral health plans (BHPs)
- **Funding eligibility:** DHCS will fund mental health plans and Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery Systems to meet milestones in the following domains
 - Payment reform
 - Implementation of Cal-AIM BH policy changes
 - Data exchange
- **Examples of eligible activities:**
 - Loading new rates into IT systems
 - Implementing standardized screening tools
 - Exchange data in the DHCS Plan Data Feed Project
- **WPC Impact:** LEs operating through the county BH department may consider this incentive opportunity
